2007 Prescrire financial report

he 2006 to 2007 fiscal year, which ended on 31 August 2007, saw an increase in subscriptions to our French edition *la revue Prescrire* as well as an upsurge of interest in our training courses.

Financial transparency

Association Mieux Prescrire (AMP) is the nonprofit organisation that publishes la revue Prescrire and Prescrire International. AMP has published its annual financial report in the March issue of la revue Prescrire since 1992 (a). AMP is subject to the same accounting and fiscal rules as all French businesses. Its accounts are independently audited.

Growth in subscriptions

The September 2007 issue of our French edition *la revue Prescrire* rose to 29 378 paying subscribers, an increase of nearly 1000 subscribers compared to the September 2006 issue (n° 275) (see table below). This growth is explained in part by the exceptional loyalty of our subscribers: the subscription renewal rate has exceeded 84% for several years now. This subscriber satisfaction is a sure sign that *Prescrire* meets a recognised need for independent and reliable information

The 94% renewal rate for subscriptions to the "*Prescrire* Integral Package" is another indication of subscriber satisfaction. As part

of this package, our subscribers receive *la revue Prescrire* along with access to the *Prescrire* website and *Prescrire* electronic library (DVD-Rom); the package can be paid for by monthly direct debit. More than 4800 subscribers to *la revue Prescrire* have also subscribed to the "*Prescrire* Integral Package" as of 31 August 2007.

Training programmes: healthy growth


Prescrire's training programme for staff members of community pharmacies was launched in April 2006. It is designed to provide training for both pharmacists and their assistants and is endorsed by the relevant French authorities (**b**). By 31 August 2007, 395 pharmacy employees had participated in these training sessions.

Prescrire's thematic training courses, based on theme-related reader tests reserved for subscribers, were launched in May 2006. The number of participants has grown from an initial 1784 to 3134 at the end of the last fiscal year. No less than 95% of subscribers who participated last year have enrolled again this year.

Prescrire's monthly readers' tests have become a classic feature for the many subscribers who participate year after year. More than 81% of last year's participants enrolled in the current session. A growing number of subscribers feel the need to participate in the monthly readers' tests, which help them to remember and apply the information presented in Prescrire. This year, more than 3200 readers subscribed to these tests.

The success of the *Prescrire* training programmes has led to a better than expected increase in income, further reinforcing the financial strength essential for our independence (see the figures on page 127).

More new projects

Investment continued in the 2006-2007 fiscal year and new programmes for subscribers were launched or prepared, including a "Professional practice programme" (endorsed by the French authorities), and the "Prevent the preventable" programme.

Prescrire's electronic library is now more user-friendly, and similar improvements are being considered for the website.

Prescrire's electronic library (on DVD-Rom) is now updated 3 times instead of twice a year. Similarly, we now publish 12 instead of 11 issues of our French edition, la revue Prescrire, per year. These changes are intended to offer our subscribers more thorough, high-quality services.



AMP: fiscal year 2006-2007




AMP consolidated budget in fiscal year 2006-2007.
